Big O Dispo LLC (“we,” “our,” “Company”) is legally required to prevent the sale of age-restricted products—including tobacco/ENDS products, intoxicating hemp products, and (when operational) medical cannabis—to individuals who do not meet the minimum age requirements. Nebraska imposes strict rules on retailers of regulated products, and we maintain a zero-tolerance policy for underage sales, diversion, or fraudulent identification.

This Age Verification Policy outlines the procedures, standards, and compliance obligations governing all in-store, online, curbside, and delivery-related age-verification processes.

1. Minimum Age Requirements

Nebraska law and federal regulations establish strict age thresholds for regulated products.

A. Hemp Products (21+)

Hemp-derived products intended for ingestion, inhalation, or with intoxicating potential are restricted to 21+ due to:

- **Nebraska’s enforcement actions against mislabeled or psychoactive cannabinoids**
- **Public health concerns related to youth access**
- **Federal guidance discouraging sales of intoxicating hemp to minors**

We require verified age for all hemp intoxicants, including THCa flower, vapes, edibles, and concentrates.

B. Tobacco & ENDS Products (21+)

Nebraska law prohibits the sale or furnishing of tobacco or ENDS products to anyone under 21 years of age.

This requirement is reinforced by:

- **FDA Tobacco 21**
- **ATF enforcement**
- **Nebraska Department of Revenue (DOR) tobacco/ENDS certification rules**

C. Medical Cannabis (Future Program)

Once Nebraska’s medical cannabis program becomes operational:

- **Only qualified patients and registered caregivers may purchase medical cannabis**
- **Customers must present valid registry identification**
- **Age requirements will follow MCC rules (e.g., minors only through registered caregivers)**



2. Required Identification

Customers must present a valid, government-issued photo ID that includes:

- Full legal name
- Date of birth
- Photo
- Expiration date

Acceptable Forms of ID

- State driver's license
- State ID card
- U.S. passport
- Military ID
- Tribal ID

Unacceptable Forms

- Expired IDs
- Digital photos of IDs
- Altered or damaged IDs
- School IDs
- Temporary paper IDs without proper verification

If an ID cannot be verified, the sale is refused.

3. Digital Age Verification (Online Orders)

For online sales of age-restricted items (hemp intoxicants, ENDS), we use a third-party digital age-verification system designed to meet state and federal standards.

Verification may require:

- Full name
- Date of birth
- Address match
- Last four digits of SSN (if required by the verification vendor)
- Device-based identity checks

Automatic Cancellation

If verification fails:

- The order is automatically canceled
- No product is shipped or prepared for pickup
- The customer may be asked to verify identity in-store

Nebraska DOR requires verified age for all online and delivery transactions involving tobacco/ENDS.



4. In-Store Age Verification

At our physical retail location:

- Customers must present valid ID before purchasing age-restricted products
- Staff are trained to inspect IDs for authenticity
- Any uncertainty results in refusal of sale

Staff Inspection Includes

- Hologram checks
- UV/blacklight verification
- Security printing
- Microprint inspection
- ID expiration review
- Comparison of physical appearance to ID photo

Nebraska law allows compliance checks and imposes penalties for under-21 sales.

5. Delivery & Pickup Age Requirements

A. Curbside Pickup

- Customer must present the same ID used for purchase
- Name on ID must match the order
- No third-party pickup unless legally permitted (e.g., registered caregivers)

B. ENDS Delivery (Where allowed)

Under the PACT Act:

- ENDS shipments require adult signature (21+)
- Carriers must verify ID at delivery
- Delivery logs must be maintained
- USPS does not deliver ENDS to consumers

We only use carriers that comply with adult-signature requirements.

C. Medical Cannabis Delivery

Nebraska does not permit medical cannabis shipping or delivery.

All dispensing must occur instore with direct ID and registry verification.

6. False Identification & Fraud Prevention

We reserve the right to:

- Refuse service to anyone using false, altered, or borrowed identification
- Ban individuals attempting circumvention or diversion
- Notify law enforcement in cases of fraudulent activity
- Cancel online orders flagged by fraud-screening tools

Nebraska law imposes penalties for furnishing restricted products to under-21 individuals and supports compliance investigations.



7. Recordkeeping

To comply with Nebraska DOR, PACT Act, and MCC requirements, we maintain secure records of:

- Digital age-verification logs
- In-store ID verification logs (where permitted by law)
- Delivery confirmation for ENDS shipments
- Patient/caregiver verification for medical cannabis (future program)

Records are:

- Stored securely
- Used only for legal compliance
- Protected under our Privacy Policy

8. Staff Training

Our staff receives ongoing training covering:

- Proper ID inspection
- Red-flag detection
- Federal and Nebraska age-restriction laws
- MCC medical cannabis verification rules
- Fraud prevention
- Reporting obligations

Training is updated regularly to reflect evolving regulations and enforcement practices.

9. Refusal of Service

We may refuse a transaction if:

- A customer cannot produce valid ID
- An ID appears fraudulent
- A digital age-verification check fails
- The customer appears intoxicated or impaired
- The customer attempts diversion or third-party purchasing
- The purchase violates any federal or Nebraska law

Refusal decisions are final to the extent permitted by law.



10. Policy Updates

This policy may be updated at any time to reflect:

- Nebraska medical cannabis program changes
- New DOR tobacco/ENDS regulations
- Updated PACT Act delivery standards
- Revised enforcement guidelines for hemp or synthetic cannabinoids
- Changes in federal age-verification requirements

Updates become effective upon posting with a revised “Last Updated” date.
